

INTRODUCTION

Donyi Polo Cultural and Charitable Trust, based in Arunachal Pradesh, is dedicated to enhancing the lives of indigenous communities in the region. Our mission focuses on preserving and promoting the rich cultural heritage of these communities. Through our unique Gurukul-styled indigenous schools across the state, we provide free education to students from diverse backgrounds. Our vision is to ensure the seamless transmission of cultural values from one generation to the next, fostering both academic growth and a strong connection to cultural roots.



Additionally, as part of our ongoing commitment to indigenous communities, we regularly organize free health camps to provide essential medical services. Supported by RITES Limited, we recently conducted free health camps at various venues including Nyedar Namlo of Doimukh, Government Secondary School of Kokila, Garung village of Balijan, Chakma village, Buddhist Temple, Block No. 9, and Techi Kako building of Tenga Baari in the Papum Pare district of Arunachal Pradesh. These camps aimed to address the healthcare needs of local residents, providing vital medical services to those in need. Below is a brief report on each of the health camps conducted.

1. Nyedar Namlo of Doimukh, Papum Pare district of Arunachal Pradesh 24/03/2024



The health camp held on March 24th, 2024, at Nyedar Namlo in Doimukh, Papum Pare district, Arunachal Pradesh, was organized by the Donyi Polo Cultural and Charitable Trust in partnership with DB Healthcare and Diagnostic Centre & Homespital, under the CSR initiative of RITES Limited. The event provided essential healthcare services to 93 individuals, addressing various health issues such as colds, sore throats, body aches and coughs.





2. <u>Government Secondary School of Kokila, Papum Pare district of Arunachal Pradesh</u>

28/03/2024



On March 28th, 2024, the 2nd Donyi Polo Cultural and Charitable Trust free health camp, supported by RITES Limited and in collaboration with DB Healthcare and Diagnostic & Homespital, was held near the Government school of Kokila in Papum Pare district, Arunachal Pradesh. The camp saw the participation of 94 patients who benefited from the free medical services provided.



3. Garung Village, Balijan, Papum Pare district of Arunachal Pradesh 29/03/2024



On March 29th, 2024, the Donyi Polo Cultural and Charitable Trust organized its 3rd free health camp at Garung village in the Balijan circle of Papum Pare district, Arunachal Pradesh. Despite being located in an interior part of the circle, the camp served a total of 32 patients. Free medical check-ups, including blood pressure, weight, and height measurements, were conducted, along with the provision of free medicines for various ailments to all participants.





4. Chakma village, Buddhist Temple, Block No-9, Papum Pare district of Arunachal Pradesh

30/03/2024



On March 30th, 2024, the 4th free health camp organized by the Donyi Polo Cultural and Charitable Trust took place at Chakma village, Buddhist Temple, Block No-9, in Papum Pare district, Arunachal Pradesh. With the generous support of RITES Limited and medical assistance provided by DB Healthcare and Diagnostic Centre & Homespital, the camp served a total of 103 patients. Participants received thorough examinations by available doctors, and free medicines were provided to address their ailments. This initiative has played a crucial role in delivering medical assistance to the most interior parts of the Chakma community, spanning across different blocks ranging from 1 to 9.



5. Techi Kako building, Tenga Bari, Balijan, Papum Pare district of Arunachal Pradesh

31/03/2024



On the 31st of March, 2024, the Donyi Polo Cultural and Charitable Trust successfully concluded its series of health camps with the final camp hosted at the Techi Kako building, located in Tenga Bari, within the Balijan circle of the Papum Pare district, Arunachal Pradesh. This concluding session was part of a comprehensive initiative supported by RITES Limited and was conducted in collaboration with DB Healthcare and Diagnostic Centre & Homespital, aiming to deliver critical medical services at no cost to the community.

Tenga Bari, positioned in a remote vicinity that shares its borders with the state of Assam, serves as a crucial location for such health camps due to its accessibility for both the residents of Arunachal Pradesh and those from the neighbouring border areas of Assam. The camp witnessed remarkable participation, registering a total of 104 patients from varied age groups on the day of the event.
