

### **GURUKULS**

Embarking on a mission to safeguard our rich cultural heritage from fading away, we, as part of DPCCT, firmly believe that education is a powerful tool for effecting positive Recognizing the challenge change. preserving traditional values among the generation of indigenous younger communities in Arunachal Pradesh, decided to establish Gurukul-style schools. These schools serve as bastions of indigenous knowledge alongside modern teachings.

At DPCCT, we are actively engaging culturally aware indigenous language teachers to facilitate our children in learning and practicing their traditional rituals, culture, sports, and other activities. By partnering with VKV to provide CBSE and modern education through its experienced teachers, our Gurukul Model is strategically positioned to deliver the education necessary for nurturing a Future-Ready Indigenous Youth. This youth will possess a deep understanding of culture and environmental concerns, thereby contributing to the creation of a sustainable world.

#### We are already in the process of establishing Gurukuls for the Apatani and Tagin communities as well.

Presently, we have established four Gurukuls: two for the Nyishi community, one for the Galo community, and one for the Adi community. However, our efforts extend beyond these communities as we are already in the process of establishing Gurukuls for the Apatani and Tagin communities as well. Through these initiatives, we are committed to preserving and promoting the cultural heritage of various indigenous communities while equipping our youth with the knowledge and skills needed to thrive in a rapidly changing world.

# NYUBU NYVGAM YERKO - RANG (NYISHI) (VILLAGE RANG, SEPPA, EAST KAMENG DISTRICT, ARUNACHAL PRADESH)

The establishment of Nyubu Nyvgam Yerko in Rang village, Seppa town, East Kameng district of Arunachal Pradesh by DPCCT represents a significant milestone in the region's educational landscape. Commencing in 2020, the school now offers classes from I to V and in the new session, 2024-25, will accommodate 143 students, compared to 113 students enrolled last year. Embracing a Gurukul-style indigenous education approach, it seamlessly integrates the CBSE-based syllabus with teachings on indigenous values and traditions. Admission to the school is exclusively open to students from the Nyishi community of the region to ensure that cultural aspects are delivered unhindered.

#### **MYOING (BHOOMI PUJA)**

On July 3rd, 2023, the children of Nyubu Nyvgam Yerko Rang enthusiastically observed the practice of Myoing (Bhoomi puja) under the guidance of a Nyubu (local priest). Myoing practice is deeply ingrained in the Nyishi community of Arunachal Pradesh, and involves offering sacrifices to the deities of nature to seek blessings for peace and prosperity.

This age-old tradition continues vibrantly at the indigenous school of Rang, where children eagerly participate year after year, actively engaging in rituals and embracing their cultural heritage. Throughout the ceremony, they immerse themselves in chants, traditional crafts, prayers, and symbolic gestures, seeking wisdom from their elders and the Nyubu who leads the ceremony.



#### **8-DAY THEATRE WORKSHOP**

From July 25th to July 31st, 2023, the Kamsa Dramatics Society organized a weeklong theatre workshop for the children of NNY, Rang. This initiative provided a valuable platform for the students to actively engage in theatrical activities.

During the workshop, facilitated by experienced instructors from Kamsa Dramatics Society, the students participated in the enactment of a documentary titled "A Word with the Future." The event aimed to impart foundational skills in drama, offering the NNY Rang students a golden opportunity to learn and grasp the basics of theatrical arts.

Despite the limited time and the tender age of the children, most of whom were hardly 10 years old, it was a moment of gratification to witness tears in the eyes of the audience, moved by the quality of performance.



#### CIVIL20 INDIA SUMMIT (C20) PARTICIPATION
